Green Dot was able to hold an event in the Ralph Engelstad Arena on January 27.

We had tables throughout the concourse handing out glowsticks, Green Dot info, and entering attendees in a giveaway for a Scheels Gift Card provided by Gate City Bank. We also showcased a new Green Dot video on the jumbotron before the game started.

This event saw more than 1400 glowsticks passed out to attendees, 433 gift card entries, and almost 11,000 viewers for our Green Dot video.

What is Green Dot?

Green Dot is a bystander intervention program dedicated to reducing violence and harm in our community through overviews, trainings, and events.



A Recetive Creen Dot is...

Any behavior, choice, word, or attitude that disrupts and prevents a situation of domestic violence, sexual assault, stalking, or child abuse.

The tools to use for Reactive Green Dots are the 3Ds:

Direct


Delegate

Distract

Do something Ask someone Do something and step in else to get random to defuse yourself. involved. the situation.

A Procedive Green Dot is...

Any behavior, choice, word, or attitude that promotes safety for everyone and communicates intolerance for domestic violence, sexual assault, stalking, and child abuse.
